### REPORT OF THE MEETING OF THE BSEC WORKING GROUP ON INSTITUTIONAL RENEWAL AND GOOD GOVERNANCE

### **Sofia, 4 May 2017**

- 1. The Meeting of the BSEC Working Group on Institutional Renewal and Good Governance was held in Sofia, on 4 May 2017.
- 2. The Meeting was chaired by Mrs. Guenoveva JETCHEVA, Head of Department on Science, Ministry of Education and Science of the Republic of Bulgaria, Representative of the Country-Coordinator.

#### AGENDA ITEM 1: ADOPTION OF THE AGENDA

AGENDA ITEM 2: IMPLEMENTATION OF THE RESOLUTIONS, DECISIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE BSEC COUNCIL AND THE FOLLOW-UP OF THE JOINT STATEMENTS (DECLARATIONS) ADOPTED BY THE MINISTERS IN CHARGE OF PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION OF THE BSEC MEMBER STATES

- 7. The BSEC PERMIS briefed the participants on the status of implementation of the Resolutions, Decisions and Recommendations of the Council and follow-up to the Joint Declarations of the Ministers in charge of Public Administration of the BSEC Member States (Athens, February 2005 and April 2007).
- 8. The issue of appointment of representatives to the Working Groups on a long term basis and the attendance of them at the meetings was raised by BSEC PERMIS.
- 9. The Working Group agreed that long term representatives of the Working Group should be nominated by the Member States. The esteemed Member States are invited to provide the updated information about their national representatives through the Secretariat by sending a Verbal Note before the next meeting of the Working Group.
- 10. The Working Group took note of the information on the developments with regard to the implementation of the "BSEC Economic Agenda 2012".
- 11. The Working Group noted that up to this moment there are no signed Agreements or Memoranda of Understanding in the sphere of Institutional Renewal and Good Governance among the BSEC Member States.

## AGENDA ITEM 3: EXAMINATION OF IMPLEMENTATION PROGRESS OF THE PLAN OF ACTION OF THE WORKING GROUP FOR 2016-2017, INCLUDING THE INFORMATION ON PREPARATION FOR CONDUCTING A HIGH LEVEL CONFERENCE IN 2017

- 12. The Country-Coordinator made a comprehensive presentation on progress achieved so far in implementing the Plan of Action for 2016-2017. The written presentation will be distributed in short period of time.
- 13. Upon the CMFA resolution (1 November, 2006, Moscow) the Country-Coordinator presented an evaluation report on the strengths, weaknesses and lessons learned in the

- activity of the Working Groups for the period June 2015- June 2017. The report will be sent shortly to the Member States.
- 14. The Working Group appreciated the work done by the Republic of Bulgaria in its capacity as a Country-Coordinator of the Working Group on Institutional Renewal and Good Governance for the period of two years /2015-2017/ and approved its evaluation report.
