

## Annex III to BS/CCLO/WG/R(2006)1

## ACTION PLAN ON COOPERATION IN COMBATING CRIME, IN PARTICULAR IN ITS ORGANIZED FORMS (May 2005 – April 2007)

The coordination of the BSEC Member States efforts with a view to valorize all cooperation opportunities offered by the BSEC including the Agreement among the Governments of the Black Sea Economic Cooperation Participating States on Cooperation in Combating Crime, in particular in its Organized Forms, signed in Kerkyra, on October the 2<sup>nd</sup>, 1998 (BSEC Agreement).

## Objectives are to promote:

- 1. Setting up of the BSEC Network of Liaison Officers on Combating Crime.
- a. Inviting BSEC Member States that have not signed the Additional Protocol to the BSEC Agreement opened for signing in Kyiv on March the 15<sup>th</sup>, 2002, to sign the document and the signatory States to undertake all necessary steps to enforce it.
- b. Appointing by the BSEC Member States of the Liaison Officers as their representatives in the Network.
- c. Organizing the first Network meeting.
- d. Organizing a training seminar for field officers involved in the combating trafficking in human beings, in Greece, at a date to be established.
- e. Organizing a training course for experts involved in countering trafficking in human beings, in Romania, in 2006.
- 2. Inviting the Member States that have not signed the Additional Protocol to the BSEC Agreement opened for signing in Athens on December the 3<sup>rd,</sup> 2004, to sign the document and the signatory States to undertake all necessary steps to enforce it.

- 3. Studying the possibility for the cooperation with the SECI Center for Combating Transborder Crime with a view to avoiding duplication and enhancing operational capacities of the two bodies.
- 4. Preparing and organizing the Seventh Meeting of the Ministers of Interior/Public Order of the BSEC Member States.
