BSEC has 13 members: Albania, Armenia, Azerbaijan, Bulgaria, Greece, Georgia, Moldova, North Macedonia, Romania, Russian Federation, Serbia, Türkiye and Ukraine. Türkiye held the Chairmanship-in-Office of the BSEC between 1 July 2023 and 1 January 2024.

During its Chairmanship-in Office our country's priority has been to bring a new momentum to the cooperation in BSEC through joint steps with the member states under the guidance of the Organization's founding principles and objectives.
